


















Fill the ceramic vessel with Candle & Lamp Oil, letting the FireLighter soak for at least 30 minutes. Carefully remove the soaked FireLighter.

Roll it lightly in the fireplace ashes. Use a match or lighter to ignite the FireLighter.

The magic is in the ashes.

Place the lit FireLighter under kindling and seasoned firewood, works best using a 2.5" or higher fireplace grate. The FireLighter will burn for approximately 15 to 20 minutes.

Allow the FireLighter to burn out in the fireplace.

Once the FireLighter is cold, carefully place it back in the ceramic vessel so it will be ready for the next fire.

- 5. Use ONLY for traditional fireplaces that have fireplace doors and/or the appropriate safety screen, a minimum 2.5" high fireplace grate, and stone or other non-combustible hearths. DO NOT use for wood stoves, wood inserts, gas fireplaces, gas stoves, gas inserts, electric fireplaces, electric stoves, or outdoor fireplaces and stoves.
- **6.** This product is not intended for and should NEVER be used as a heater.
- 7. Be aware that the FireLighter is extremely hot when in use. ALWAYS take necessary and appropriate precautions to prevent injury, including but not limited to protective gloves or tongs.
- **8.** NEVER attempt to modify the FireLighter or the ceramic vessel.
- **9.** The FireLighter should be stored ONLY in the ceramic vessel, provided by the manufacturer. ALWAYS keep the ceramic vessel away from heat.
- 10. Never place the FireLighter in the ceramic vessel until the FireLighter has completely cooled.
- 11. NEVER use unapproved accessories with this product.
- 12. DO NOT use the FireLighter if it has been damaged in any manner.
- 13. ALWAYS check to make sure that no unintended materials are exposed to the FireLighter.
- 14. DO NOT wash or clean the FireLighter.
- 15. ALWAYS have a fire extinguisher near by when using the FireLighter should a fire break out.
- **16.** Before igniting the FireLighter make sure it is securely connected to the handle. DO NOT use if the FireLighter is loose or disconnected from the handle.
- 17. Once ignited, the FireLighter can be difficult to extinguish. ALWAYS let the FireLighter burn itself out in the fire area of the fireplace before removing. ONLY remove from fireplace with fireplace tongs. ALWAYS allow the FireLighter to cool completely on the fireplace hearth before carefully replacing in ceramic vessel. ALWAYS take necessary and appropriate precautions to prevent injury while the FireLighter cools on the hearth.
- 18. When not in use, keep the FireLighter and ceramic vessel away from direct heat. Store the FireLighter ONLY in the ceramic vessel on a level, stable, non-combustibles surface.
- 19. NEVER ignite the FireLighter in the vicinity of the ceramic vessel or any other combustible material.
- 20. ONLY use Candle & Lamp Oil sold with this product. All other lighter fluids are NOT approved by the manufacturer and could be extremely dangerous.
